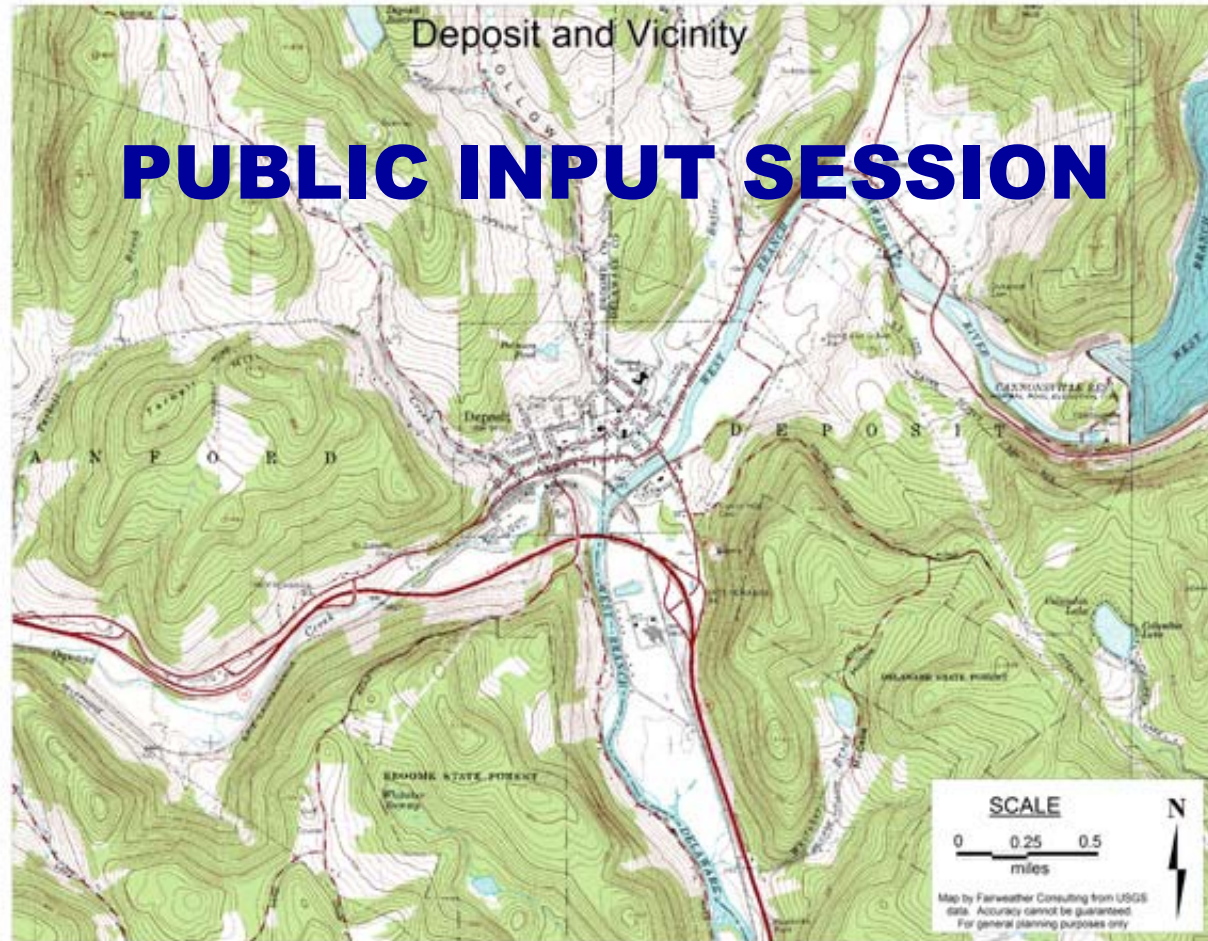

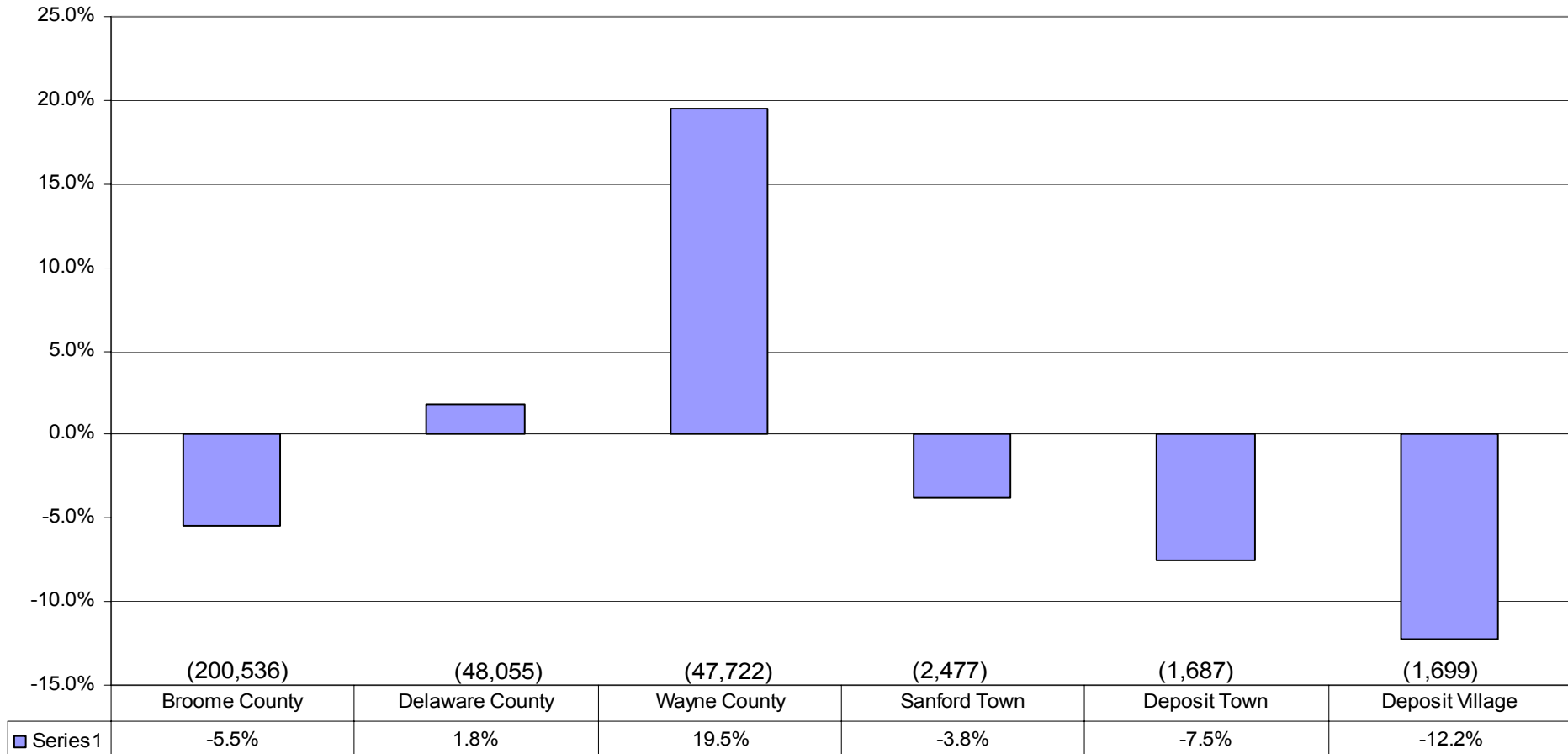

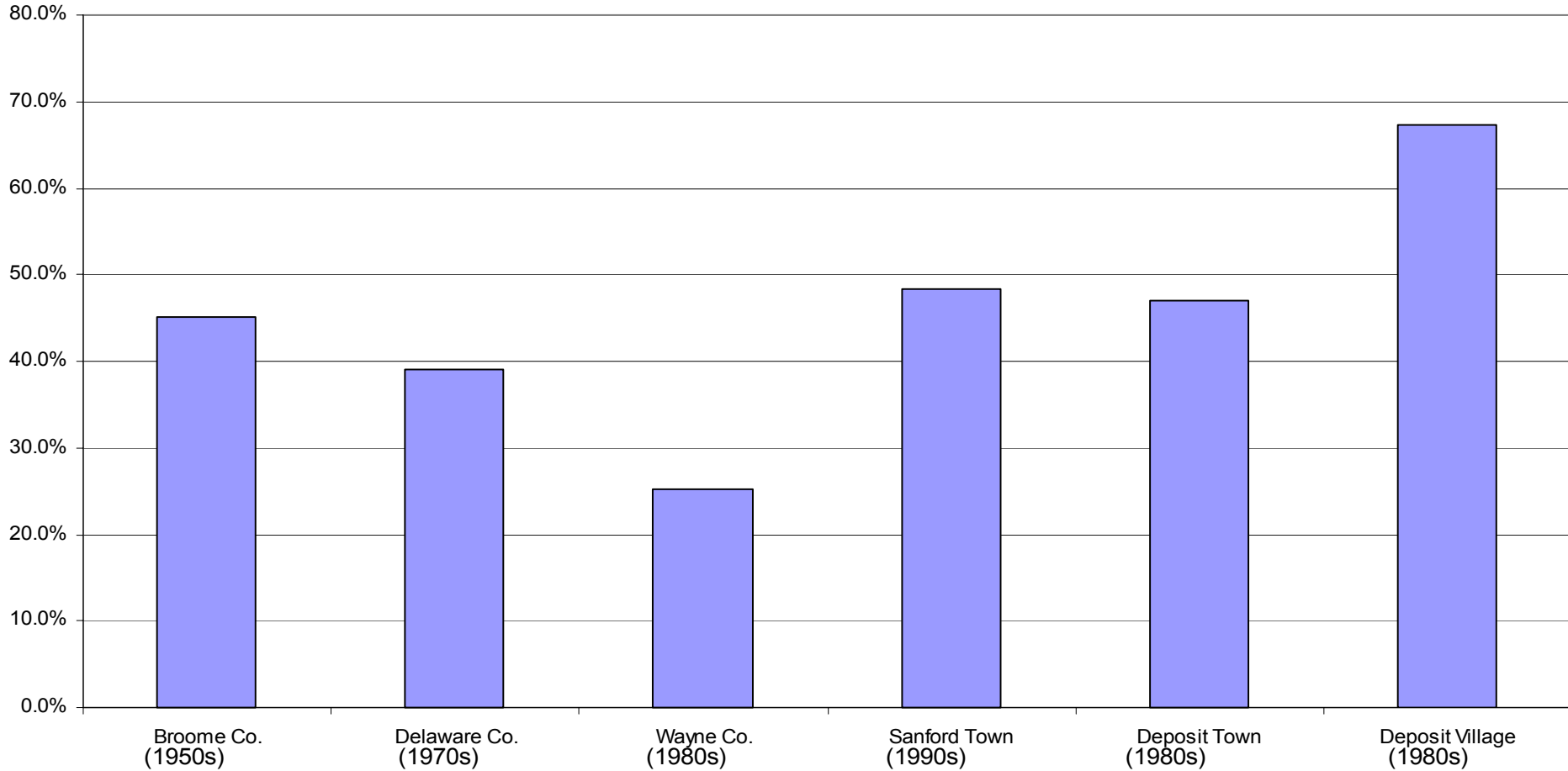

(2000 Total in Parentheses)



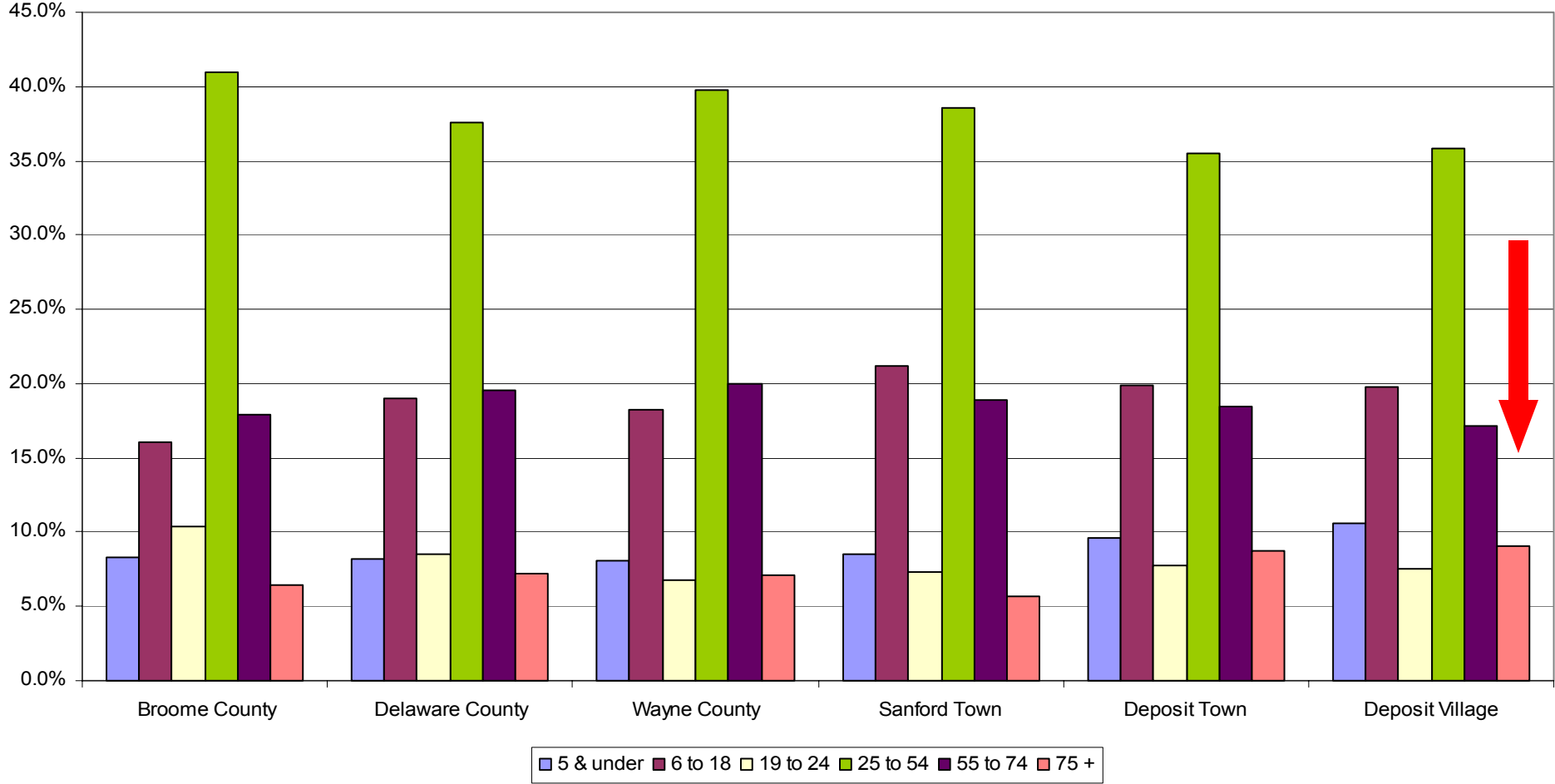
TYPICALLY, THE VILLAGE HAS THE OLDEST HOUSING

(Peak Post-War Decade for Construction in Parentheses)



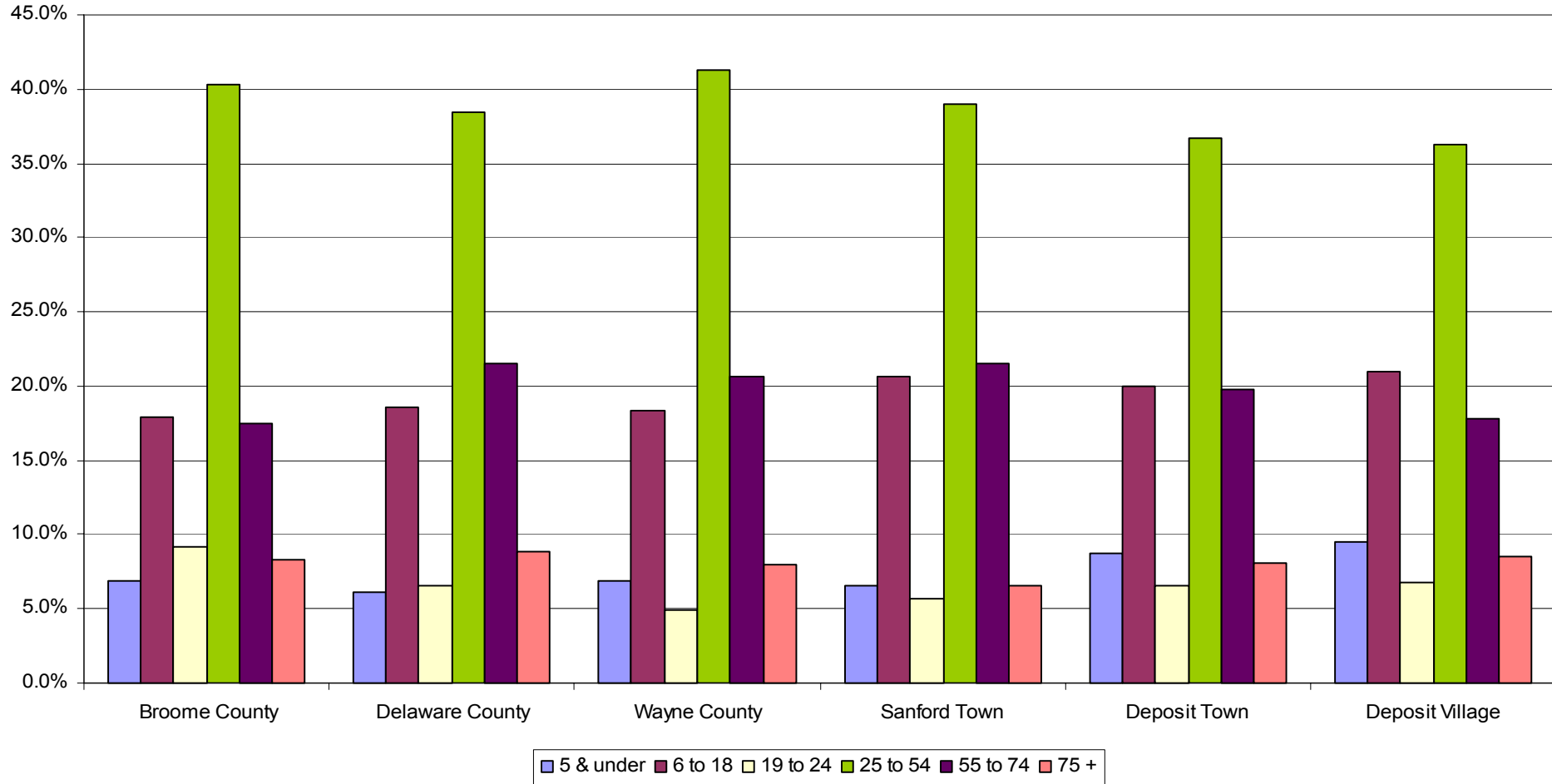
POPULATION AGE: IN 1990 DEPOSIT HAD A HIGH % OVER 75

Age Distribution by Area, 1990



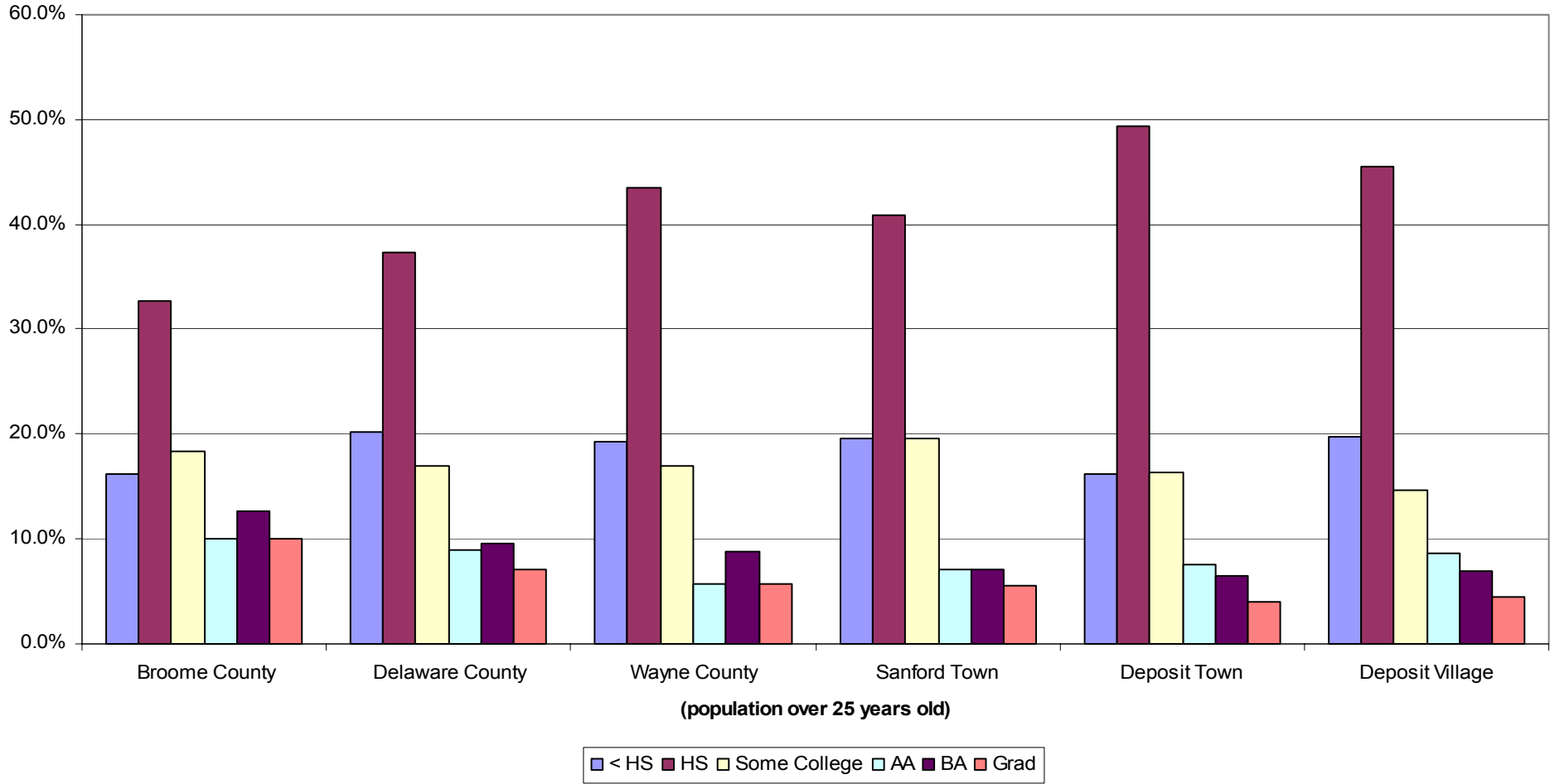
DURING THE 1990s, ALL AREAS SAW A SHIFT TO AN OLDER POPULATION

Age Distribution by Area, 2000



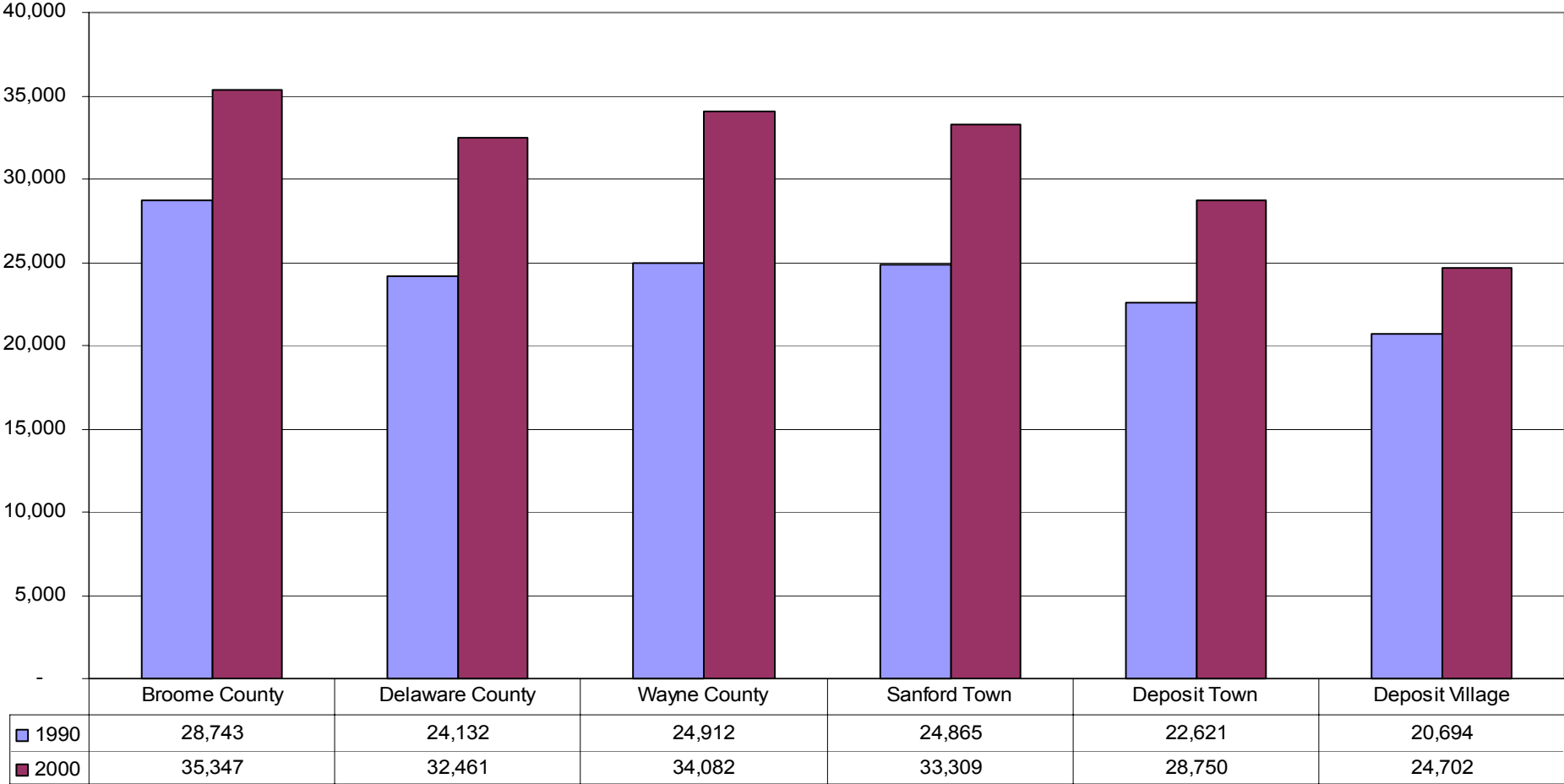
THE DEPOSIT/SANFORD AREA HAS LESS ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

Education Level by Area



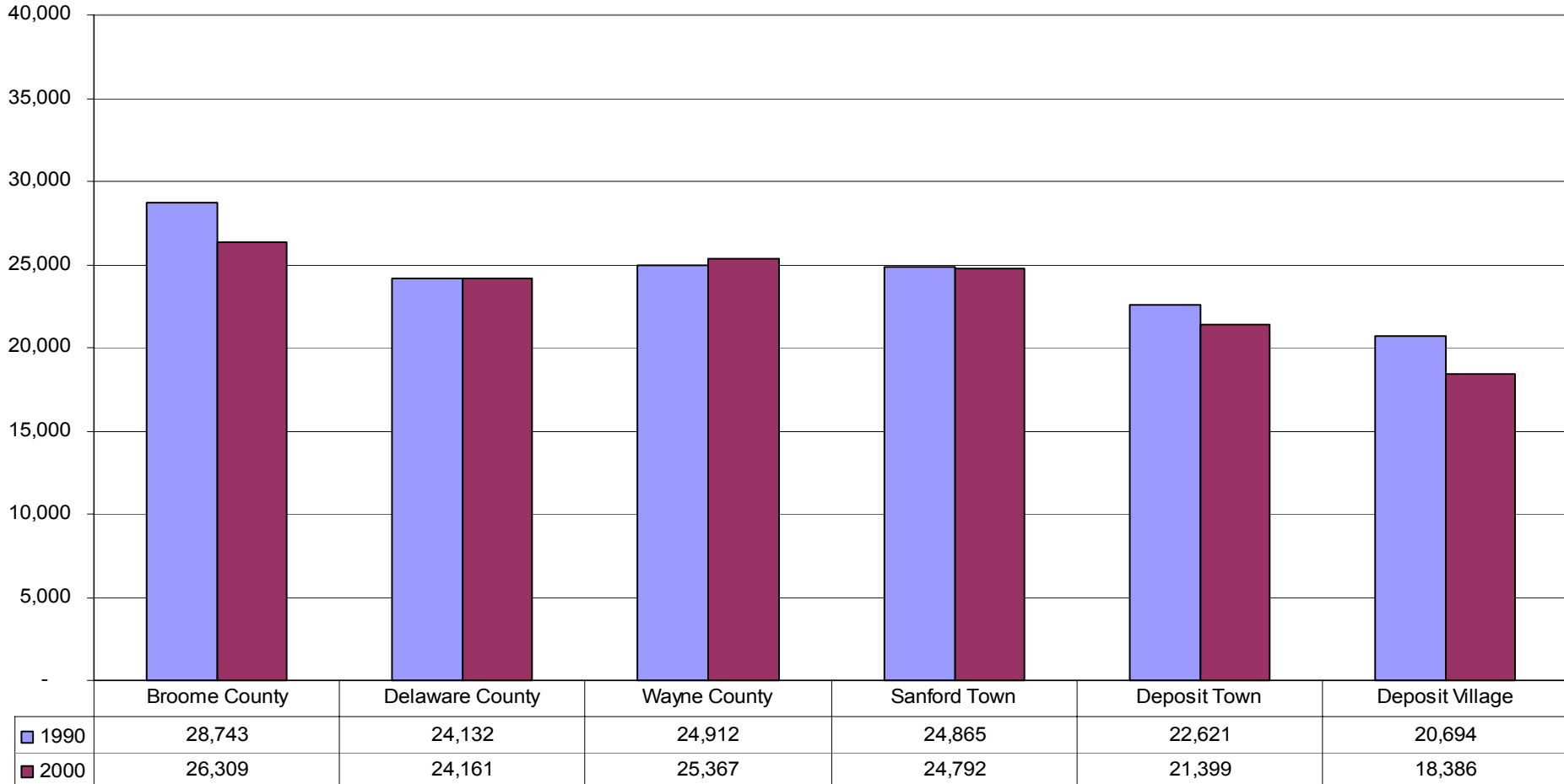
INCOMES SEEM TO BE INCREASING. . .

Median Household Income, 1989 & 1999



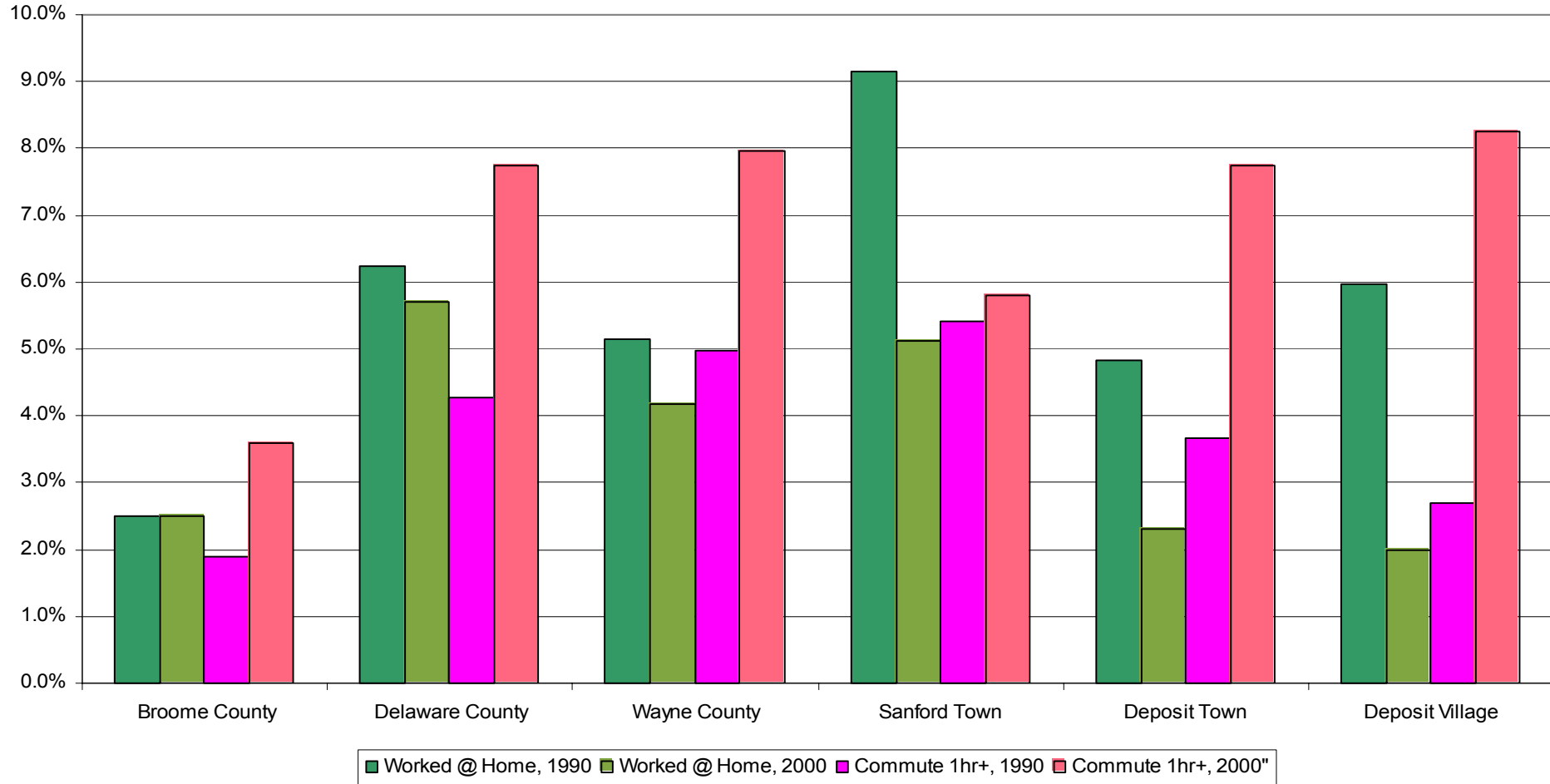
